

Second District Chapter of Credit Unions 2017 Scholarship Information

THREE-\$500 Scholarships Will Be Awarded

1. Open to 2017 graduating high school seniors.
2. Student, parent, guardian or grandparent must be a member of a second district chapter credit union.
3. Scholarships will be awarded based on results of a test given on January 21, 2017. Study Materials may be picked up at any of the following chapter members: Power CoOp Credit Union - Humboldt, Peoples - Webster City/ Fort Dodge, Fort Dodge Family Credit Union - Fort Dodge, and Citizens Community Credit Union. **“A Guide to Money,”** and **“There’s Nothing Like a Credit Union”**. A general knowledge of the Credit Union will also be needed.
4. The scholarship test must be taken Saturday, January 21, 2017, between 8:30am and 11:30am at Fort Dodge Family Credit Union, 407 2nd Ave S, Fort Dodge. Please arrive before 11 AM.

If it is not possible to take the test at the scheduled time and/or location, your local school counselor may contact Julie Pingel (Phone: 515-573-1160) to make other arrangements for testing by January 19, 2017. All completed tests must be returned by the School Counselor and must be at Fort Dodge Family Credit Union no later than 5:30 p.m. January 20, 2017. 5. The test will contain true or false, multiple choice and matching questions. It will take about 30 minutes to complete.
6. The winner will be announced no later than graduation.
7. The scholarship check will be paid to the winner when proof of college enrollment is provided in the fall. The proof should be sent to the winner’s credit union to the attention of Second District Chapter Treasurer.
